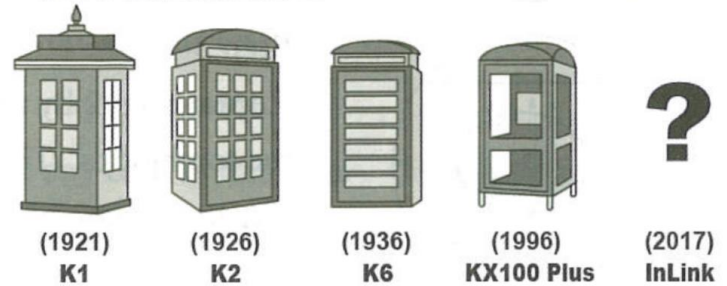
Millions of people enjoy taking photos of red phone boxes when they visit the UK. But do you know when the history of those red phone boxes began? In fact, the first red phone box was built on a street of London in 1921. It was called “K1,” which meant Kiosk No. 1, with a white roof and red windows. Many years later, some people in the UK didn’t think “K1” was beautiful enough, so “K2” was designed and built in 1926. Almost every part of “K2” was red, which made itself very different from “K1.”

“K2” was more popular, but it cost too much money to build a phone box like “K2,” so more different kinds of phone boxes have been designed since then. Those phone boxes were almost the same as “K2,” and most parts of them were red. In many people’s minds, “K6” was their favorite phone box, which was designed in 1936 to honor George V, who had been the king for twenty-five years. To honor the days of this important king, K6 was also called “Jubilee Kiosk.”

With more people using cellphones, a modern phone box called InLink was designed and built around London in 2017. It has a large screen on which you can see useful information. You can also use its free Wi-Fi to get on the Internet or make free phone calls with

InLink, but a lot of people still miss old “K6” much.

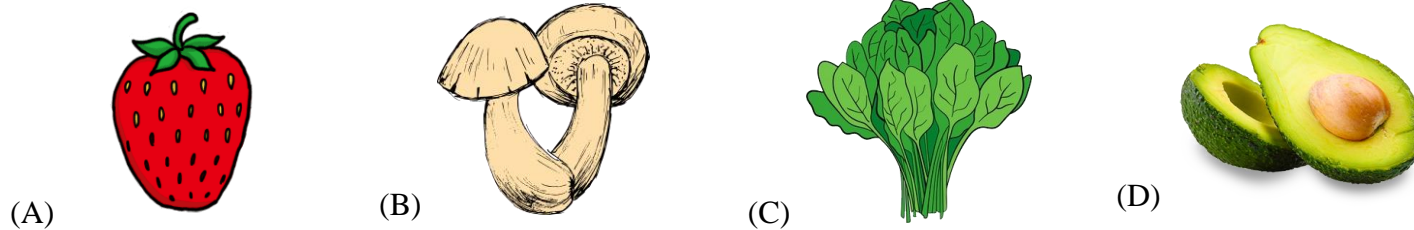
