It has been for seven days since 156 people were killed in a Halloween crush in the South Korean capital. The names and stories of those who died have come out, along with details of missed warnings and hopeless calls for help.

According to police emergency call records, a lot of calls were made as early as four hours before the sad event happened when the crowd in Itaewon, Seoul's busy nightlife area, became so crowded that partygoers were unable to move or breathe.

The videos taken by partygoers on that night showed those people moved slowly at first, and then rushed in panic. Unfortunately, it was supposed to be a fun night, but it turned out to be out of control.

Police finally sent four police officers to the site that evening, but too few and too late to avoid the disaster. Families are crying over the loss of their loved ones who were most in their teens and 20s. 
The Maya lived there 4,000 years ago (about 2000 BC). At that date many societies were living in the Maya region. The main foods of the Maya diet were grown. Their food included corn, beans, pumpkins, and chili peppers. The first Maya cities developed around 750 BC.

The Maya people used a written language and a numeral system. They were good at art, building, and their priests studied stars and planets, which helped them make calendars.

The Maya civilization was biggest between the years of 420 AD and 900 AD. The Maya civilization spread all the way from central Mexico to Honduras, Guatemala, and northern El Salvador.

It is estimated that at its maximum, the civilization had at least ten million people. The Maya people traded with other people in the Americas. Their art and buildings have many different styles. This shows they traded a lot. They made changes to their buildings to make them even better. The Maya civilization started getting smaller after 900 AD.

The Conquistadors arrived in the 15th century and took over Mexico and later Central America, even in the Mayan areas. However, the Maya people still live there today. They live in the same areas the Mayan civilization used to live in. They keep the old Mayan traditions and beliefs. There are many Mayan languages still spoken today, including one called the Achi language.



What are the best exercises for those who are busy and no time to exercise in the gym? Four “workouts” below can do something new and surprising for your health. They will help keep your weight under control, improve your balance of motion, make your bones strong, protect your knees, keep from bladder(膀胱) control problems, and even avoid memory loss. No matter what your age or health level is, these activities are some of the best exercises you can do and will help you get in shape and lower your risk for disease.

1. Swimming

You might call swimming the best workout. In the water, the exercise can cut down the pain of joints. “Swimming is good for the people who have arthritis (關節炎) because it’s less with-bearing,” explains Dr. I-Min Lee, professor of medicine at Harvard Medical School. Research has found that swimming can also help you in a better mood.

2. Tai chi

This Chinese martial art (武術) that links movement and relaxation is good for both body and mind. In fact, it is been called “meditation” (冥想) in motion. “Tai chi is made up of a series of peaceful movements, one passing slowly into the next. Because the classes are offered at many levels, tai chi is for people of all ages and health levels. “It’s especially good for older people because balance is an important reason of health, and balance is something we lose as we get older,” Dr. Lee says.

Take a class to help you get started and learn the proper form. You can find tai chi programs at your local YMCA, health club, community center, or senior center.

3. Walking

Walking is simple, but powerful. It can help you stay healthy, make strong on bones, keep blood pressure(血壓) in check, lift your mood, and lower your risk for a number of diseases like heart disease. A lot of studies have shown that walking and other physical activities can even improve memory and avoid memory loss because of the age.

How to do? All you need is a well-fitting and good pair of shoes for walking. Start with walking for about 10 to 15 minutes at a time. Over time, you can start to walk farther and faster, until you are walking for 30 to 60 minutes on most days of the week.

4. Kegel exercises

These exercises won't help you look better, but they have a lot of benefits for your health such as make strong on the pelvic (骨盆的) floor muscles that support the bladder. While many women are familiar with Kegels, these exercises can do good to men too.

To do a Kegel exercise right, first, you need to squeeze (擠壓) the muscles you would use to avoid yourself from passing urine (尿) or gas. Second, hold the contraction (收縮) for two or three seconds, and then set free. Make sure to completely relax your pelvic floor muscles after the contraction. Repeat Step 1 and Step 2 for 10 times. Try to do four to five sets a day.

As long as you do some kinds of aerobic (有氧的) exercise for at least 30 minutes a day, and include two days of strength training a week, you can think yourself an "active" person.


